
GAME NIGHT: FEB. 24

Drop students and siblings off in the Auditorium for a movie and games.


9:30 am: Math with grade-level teacher in classrooms

Dental Screening and Sealant Program

Free Dental Exams and Sealant Placement

We are offering dental screening and sealants in partnership with the IWS Children's Clinic. **Your Child's School** was chosen to take part in this project, which provides free dental exams and sealant placement.

*Eligible children covered by Medicaid Insurance will also receive dental cleaning and fluoride. * If it has been 6 months or more since last cleaning/fluoride.

You will receive a copy of your child's dental exam after he/she is seen.

If you wish for your child to participate please take a few minutes to read this letter, complete the consent form on the back of this sheet and return it to your child's teacher as soon as possible.

Screening will take place during the **2017-2018** school year.

Q & A

Q: What are dental sealants?

A: Dental sealants are thin plastic coatings that are put onto the chewing surfaces of the back teeth. Sealants are painted on the top of the back teeth and harden to form a protective shield over the tooth.

Q: Does it hurt to have sealants put on teeth?

A: No, getting sealants is painless. Right after placement, normal activities can resume.

Q: How long will sealants last?

A: Sealants can last five to ten years if they are done right and teeth are properly cared for after placement.

Q: How do sealants prevent cavities?

A: Dental sealants fill the pits and grooves of the teeth. The teeth are easier to keep clean because the food is easier to brush off with your toothbrush.

Q: Is brushing still important when teeth have sealants on them?

A: Yes, brush and floss every day!



Release of Liability for the Dental Program. I give my consent for the IWS Children's Clinic sponsored by the Oak Park River Forest Infant Welfare Society, to provide dental care to my child. I hereby release, waive and discharge the **IWS Children's Clinic and School District** their employees and agents, from any liability to me, my personal representatives or next of kin for any and all damages, and any claim or demands made on account of injury or dental disease resulting from the dental procedures. I have read and understood this agreement and voluntarily agree to all of its terms and conditions. I understand that the IWS Children's Clinic is providing these procedures as a public service. This authorization expires five years from this date. This will also grant permission for IDPH Quality Assurance Audits to be performed and providers to return to your school to recheck your child's sealants within 365 days from this date. This Dental Health Services Program was provided by the IWS Children's Clinic with funding from the Illinois Department of Public Health. Dentists and dental hygienists will come to your child's school with portable equipment to perform these services. In order for your child to fully participate, you **MUST** complete the form and SIGN below. Any child who returns a form will be eligible to receive dental treatment. Do not return this form if you are not interested in the services.
