Procedures

1. Year 1 – Research and Study
 - Review best practices and current research
 - Review evaluation of previous curriculum
 - Request comments from staff, parents, and community
 - Request sample materials
 - Review and select pilot materials
 - Review and revise curriculum documents

2. Year 2 – Pilot and Purchase Materials
 - Prepare final draft of curriculum documents
 - Pilot materials
 - Select and present materials request to School Board
 - Provide a period of public review following the first Board presentation
 - Order and inventory new materials
 - Plan for staff development on new materials
 - Develop common assessments

3. Year 3 – Implementation and Staff Development
 - Deliver materials to the schools
 - Provide staff development and support
 - Design exemplary classroom units for dissemination
 - Troubleshoot implementation issues

4. Years 4-6 – Monitor and Adjust
 - Adjust common assessments
 - Supplement classroom materials
 - Continue development of classroom units

5. Years 7-8 – Program Evaluation
 - Phase 1 – Review and evaluate initial program goals
 - Phase 1 – Survey staff, students, and community
 - Phase 2 – Review overall costs of the program
 - Phase 2 – Plan for upcoming budget years
 - Phase 2 – Make decisions about revising or discontinuing old program materials
