CLASS INFORMATION

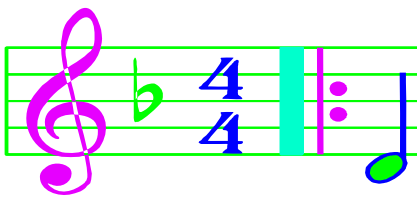
Classes will be held at Gwendolyn Brooks Middle School from August 3, 2009 - August 14, 2009.

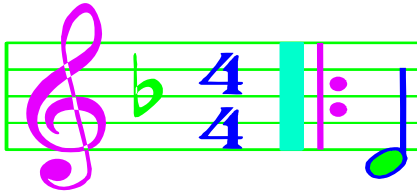
BAND I

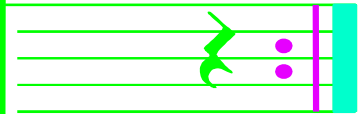
ORCHESTRA I

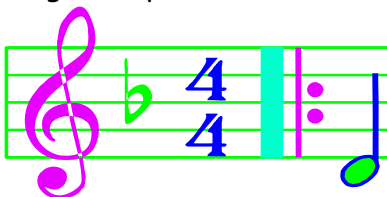
CHORUS II

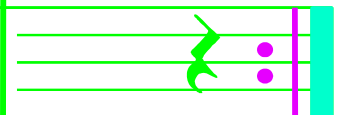
JAZZ BAND II
