District 97 is excited to announce our summer programming for 2024!

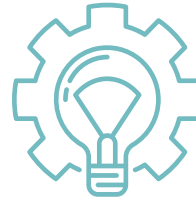
Responding to a call for innovative learning, our summer programs offer a mix of subject matter. We hope your student will find a summer program that helps them continue to grow and also enjoy with other students.

Students who are currently accelerated in math are not eligible.

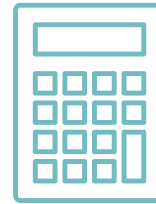

Summer FUNdational Camp

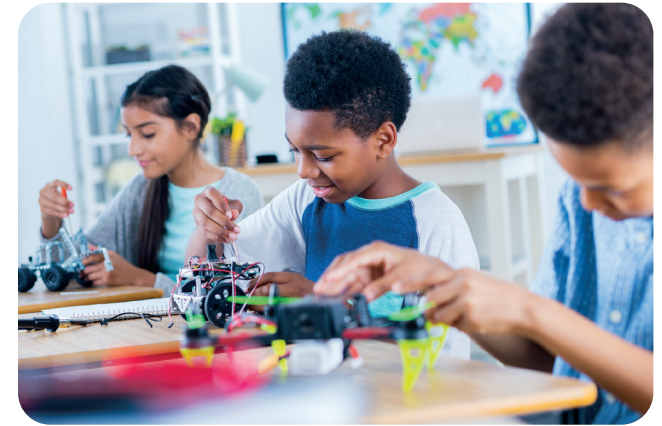
Grades K-2

Students who qualify for free or reduced lunch

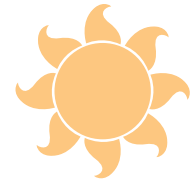
