

Dear parent of (Example):

We are using a program called XtraMath to increase speed and accuracy in arithmetic. (Example) is invited to spend a few minutes each day practicing math on a computer, tablet, or phone. If you would like (Example) to do XtraMath on a tablet or smartphone, look for XtraMath in the app store. The app costs \$5. On a laptop or desktop computer, he/she can do XtraMath for free at xtramath.org.

Here's what you need to do: In the app or on the website, select Enroll.

Enter your email address and (Example)'s enrollment code, (Contact Mrs. Feichter if you need an enrollment code. The students are already enrolled and their PINs have been sent to them.).

This will (1) create a parent account for you if you don't have one, (2) link (Example)'s account to your account so you can review his/her progress, and (3) save (Example)'s account information for easy sign-in on that computer or device.

If you already have a parent account for (Example) from a previous class or personal use, then this enrollment process will allow (Example) to resume XtraMath where he/she left off rather than starting over in my classroom.

Think of XtraMath as a math vitamin! For best results, (Example) should do XtraMath once per day as regularly as possible. It only takes a few minutes so make it a part of your daily routine. Math facts are the building blocks of your child's math education and your child will be well rewarded for the time they spend practicing on XtraMath.
