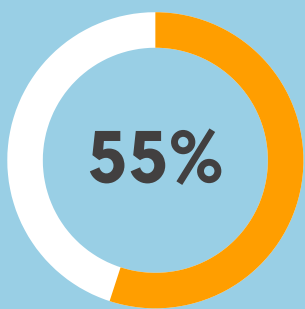

## How can the PTO better serve students?

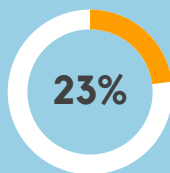
Clubs, clubs, clubs! This idea stood out with many comments and suggestions asking how to connect kids with shared interests



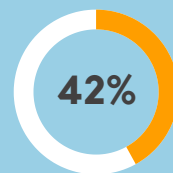
Supported the idea of the PTO coordinating play dates or gatherings among students



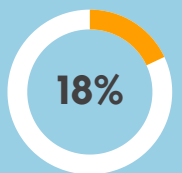

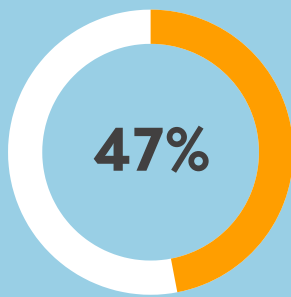

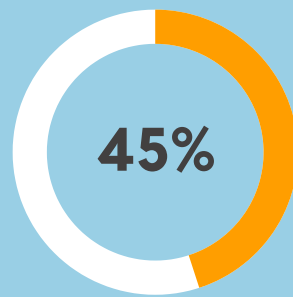

## How can the PTO better support teachers?

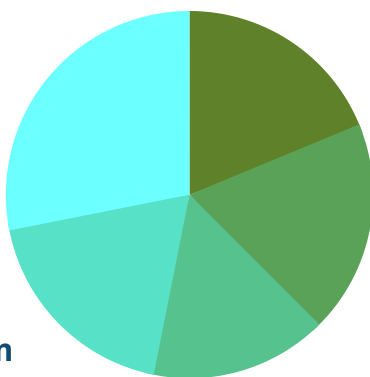
Fund activities like the talent show
